

FRED EBB AWARD GUIDELINES

Eligibility:

Applicant must be a lyricist, composer, or composer/lyricist team wishing to create works for the musical theatre. In addition, applicant must meet at least one of the following requirements:

1. Work by the applicant has been produced on stage or in workshop;
 2. At least one song by the applicant has been published, recorded, or performed professionally;
 3. Applicant is or has been a member of a professional musical theatre workshop (such as ASCAP or BMI) or a musical theatre development program.
- Only applicants who have not yet achieved significant commercial success may apply.
 - A songwriting team should submit a single application.

Application Materials:

1. A CD of between four and six songs for one or more musical theatre pieces, with typewritten lyrics to each song;
 2. A thorough description of the dramatic context for each song; and
 3. A completed application form.
- Please do not submit originals; no materials will be returned.
 - Because the submissions will be reviewed blind, please do not place name(s) of writer(s) on the CD, lyric sheets, or description of dramatic context.
 - Only musical theatre work will be considered.

Submission Deadline and Award:

Applications will be accepted from May 1, 2005 through June 30, 2005. Please mail applications to Fred Ebb Award, Roundabout Theatre, 231 West 39th Street, Suite 1200, New York, New York 10018. The winner will be selected in November 2005.
